Background

Since January 2021, all large physical **electrical and electronic retailers*** (band A and B) are obliged to **accept consumers' old electricals in store for recycling, and tell customers** about this service.

We worked with the *Department for Business and Trade* to develop this toolkit of communications to help ensure consistency across all consumer communications relating to retailer take-back.

- Minimum requirement - retailers will need to **accept old electricals that they sell on a like-for-like basis**, meaning if you buy a charger, a kettle, a vape, or other electricals from your local electrical retailer then you can drop off your old one there
- **Brands with multi-site stores** selling a variety of different products may need to communicate differently in different stores, and should ensure that store staff advise consumers, that larger goods can only be returned to specific stores
- Some electrical and electronic retailers take back all electricals regardless of what you're buying e.g. Currys, B&Q, John Lewis

**Physical retailers selling less than £100k of electrical items, and larger online retailers, can remain part of Phase 6 of the DTS scheme until the 31st December 2023*

Why should you promote Retailer Take-back?

- In order to **comply with retailer WEEE obligations**
- To **make it easier for customers** to act sustainably - only 12%* of the UK public are aware they can recycle their old electricals in-store but 81%* say they either use or would use the service if it was available
- To **attract non-customers** into your store

But also:

- Offers your brand opportunity to **demonstrate commitment** to helping your customers reduce their environmental impact - and be genuinely **socially useful** - not just **because legislation has forced you to**
 - **The way you communicate** and implement retailer take-back will influence sustainability and brand perceptions
 - Three in four UK adults (77%)** say they would view an electrical retailer as more environmentally responsible if they knew they offered electrical recycling
 - 69%** say this would improve their image of the retailer

Minimum requirement for Retailer Take-back communications

Retailers must accept consumers' old electricals in store for recycling - and **tell customers about this service**. We worked with OPSS/Dept for Business and Trade (DBT) to help **ensure consistency** across all consumer communications. Our toolkit contains **ready-made and editable assets** and key messaging to enable you to meet your obligations. There are **like-for-like, recycle all, and recycle vapes** options.

Mandatory

- Point of sale comms - for use at the points in the store where you sell electricals
- Website copy - on how customers can reuse and recycle electrical and electronic equipment

How to communicate vape recycling to the public

NEVER BIN THEM - RECYCLE ALL YOUR VAPES

Batteries in vapes can cause fires when binned

Rechargeable vapes

Recycle the battery separately if it is removable

- If you can remove the battery, drop it in a **battery recycling bin**
- Put the rest of the vape in a **vape recycling bin**
- If there isn't a separate bin for vapes, recycle yours with other small electricals

If the battery is not removable, recycle the whole thing with vapes or other small electricals

Single-use vapes

Leave the battery inside and recycle the whole thing

- Drop the vape in a vape recycling bin
- If there isn't a separate bin for vapes, recycle yours with other small electricals

E-liquid/ vape juice pods

These may contain metals or electrical components

- Put pods in the vape recycling bin

If there isn't a separate bin for vapes, recycle yours with other small electricals

Buying a new electrical or electronic item from us? From 1st January 2022, as part of our commitment to reducing the amount of unwanted electrical waste being incinerated or sent to landfill sites, we ensure your old electricals are recycled. Everything with a plug, battery or cable can be recycled for free at our collection points.

1. In-store electrical and electronic recycling

For a better way to part with old broken or unwanted goods, drop off your unwanted electrical and electronic products in one of our stores for free - that way you can be sure they're recycled responsibly. We'll also take light bulbs, fluorescent tubes and batteries in our recycling units. You'll find them near our checkouts. For any larger products, we can help dispose of them responsibly to ensure if you've bought a new item from us, we'll take the old one away for you.

WASTE ELECTRICAL, ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT (WEEE) AND BATTERY RECYCLING

We offer a free recycling service for waste electrical and electronic equipment (WEEE) that you're able to return to our shops. We'll also offer to take away your old small electrical items for free when we're delivering a large item or appliance to you (as long as we have space to take it).

Unwanted electrical equipment is the UK's fastest-growing type of waste. Many electrical items can be repaired or recycled, saving natural resources and the environment. If not recycled, electrical equipment will often end up in landfill where hazardous substances can leak out and cause soil and water contamination, which can harm wildlife and human health.

RECYCLING OLD ITEMS IN STORE

You can bring your old electrical items to be recycled at any John Lewis & Partners shop.

- The item you want to return and recycle doesn't need to have been bought from us (either online or in store).
- If your item is very small, and less than 25cm on its longest side, then you can take it to one of our branches whenever you wish.
- If your item is larger than 25cm on its longest side, we will currently accept a like-for-like equivalent when you are purchasing a new item.
- Please make sure the item you're returning is clean and dry, and that any personal data has been removed from its memory - follow the instructions on the device to restore to factory settings or follow [this handy guide](#) supplied by [www.recycleyour-electricals.org.uk](#)
- If you're not sure how to remove your personal data, we offer an in-store service where our specialist Partners will clear all data from your old device. There's a small fee for this service. [Find out more](#)

What can I recycle?

When did this happen?

The Retailer Take-back scheme kicked in on 1 January 2021 across the UK.

Who is taking part?

Any large shop that sells electricals will take your old item if you buy new from them.

What can I recycle in store?

Everything with a plug, battery or cable can be recycled - even the plugs, batteries and cables themselves. If you've bought a new electrical or electronic product from us, we'll recycle your old one for you for free. For everything else, find your local reuse or recycling point on the [Recycle Your Electricals website](#).

Will you only take back goods if I bought from you in the first place?

No. You could have bought your old product from any retailer.

Does my new item have to be the same brand as the old one?


No. You can take back a broadly similar type of product, of any brand. So if you buy a DVD player, we will accept your old VHS player for recycling.



How do I recycle electricals with the Retailer Take-back scheme?

Do I need to prepare my electricals in any way before recycling?

It's as easy as ABC

A: Anything with a plug, cable or battery can be recycled

If your item is still in working order, could it be [donated](#) to a local charity shop? Or to someone you know? Could you [sell](#) your unwanted item? Or, if it's broken, could it be [repaired](#)?

B: Bag them up

Bag up all of your unwanted, unused or broken electrical items, ready to take to your local drop-off point.

C: Check

Find your nearest recycling point. Simply enter your postcode in the [recycling locator](#). And off you go.

Before handing over any electricals for recycling, make sure you remove:

- **Data** - delete and destroy your personal data from smart devices such as phones, watches, games consoles and smart speakers. See this guide on [how to delete your data](#)
- **Loose batteries**, lightbulbs, memory cards and SIM cards.

Remember, anything with a plug, battery or cable can and should be recycled. Never bin them - bag up your electricals ready for recycling. Visit ['Recycle Your Electricals'](#) to find out more.
