



BUY LESS

PASS IT ON

FIX IT

Before you bin that broken gadget, check if it can be fixed. A little DIY can make your tech last way longer. Plus, fixing stuff basically makes you a tech wizard.

SELL IT

Make some pocket money (parent's permission required alert!). It's easy to sell your old gadgets online. There are loads of websites that can help you do this. Ker-ching!

RECYCLE IT

Did you know 75% of the materials in old tech can be recycled and turned into awesome new things? Getting materials from our unwanted electricals means we have to dig way fewer massive holes in the ground through mining. And recycling is easier than finding your lost sock – with over 20,000 drop-off points already in the UK.

SPREAD THE WORD
